Stowarzyszenie Chorych na Mukopolisacharydoze (MPS) i Choroby Rzadkie (<http://choroby rzadkie.pl>) is a charity which provides support to families with Children suffering from MPS (Mucopolisaccharidosis) and related disorders in Poland. The diseases manifest themselves in many ways, typically affecting the development of bones and affecting organs, senses and the brain. Untreated, many children suffering from MPS do not live to see adulthood. Children suffering from these diseases often require constant care as a result of debilitation and families in Poland generally do not have local access to specialist medical treatment, the only facility providing any recognised form of treatment being at Międzylesie, near Warsaw. Besides an immeasurable amount of emotional support, the charity provides equipment for improved home care, works closely with the Specialist at Międzylesie to ensure that as many children as possible are given care, gives advice on obtaining state benefits, provides access to specialist medical support at events and conferences, disseminates translated information related to international developments in treatment, raises awareness about the disease, co-ordinates action to secure treatment for Children in Poland (Co-operates with the Ministry of Health with the aim of securing treatment in Poland, where treatment has been developed internationally).
